Below you will find information regarding your child starting with us that you may find useful.

School Uniform

Our school uniform looks very smart; our children wear it with pride. Below we have listed the school uniform expectations.

- Grey or Black Trousers, shorts or skirt
- Sky blue polo shirt
- Navy sweatshirt or cardigan
- Black Shoes

Optional

- School baseball cap
- Blue gingham dress
- White shirt and school tie
- Navy fleece
- Navy coat

PE and Games

- White PE T-Shirt
- Navy PE Shorts (not Bermudas)
- Black Plimsolls/Trainers

In addition, a tracksuit or an old jumper is useful in winter for outdoor games. A PE bag with drawstring is useful and we ask that all kit and equipment is clearly labelled.

Our uniform provider is Nationwide Uniforms www.nationwideschooluniforms.co.uk. Many items of non-personalised uniform such as black trousers, sky blue polo shirts, and navy sweatshirt/ cardigans are also available at other retailers.

We ask parents to make sure that all items of clothing and equipment are **clearly marked with their child's name**. Trying to identify one Belton Lane sweatshirt from 300 others is a daunting task!

Shoes should be comfortable, and parents are asked to avoid buying their daughters shoes which have a noticeable heel or an open toe as these may cause accidents.

Black trainers are acceptable as school shoes providing they are all black. Footwear for games and PE must be suitable and separate footwear from everyday use.

Please do not send in expensive items of clothing like designer bags or coats. We cannot accept responsibility for items of clothing lost or damaged in school.

Jewellery

We prefer children not to wear jewellery to school. Small sleepers or studs may be worn in pierced ears during the school day but must be removed for all PE activities for health and safety reasons. Wrist watches can be worn to school, but the school cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage. Nail varnish should not be worn in school.

Please ensure that you state your child's name and class and we will send any ordered items home with your child.

Meals in School

Children can have a hot/cold school meal each day which parents order online through Arbor.

Please note: you must order school meals by midnight on Thursday for the following week to enable the kitchen to place their food order.

The meals in school are freshly cooked on site in our kitchen by our catering partner Taylor Shaw. If you would like more information about Taylor Shaw, then please visit their website [Taylor Shaw Catering for Schools & the Educational Sector](#). They offer a healthy, well-balanced menu with three choices of main course each day as well as a dessert or fruit.

Parents/Carers are responsible for informing school if their children have any known food allergies.

Alternatively, children can bring a healthy packed lunch. All children are encouraged to have a water bottle in school and can access this throughout the day. Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are also offered a piece of fruit at morning playtime. Reception children are also provided with a drink of milk each day until they reach their 5th birthday.

Breakfast Club

We have an on-site breakfast club that is open from 7.45 am Monday to Friday during term time. This is situated in the school hall and is accessed at the back of the school.

This provision is staffed by school staff and offers a healthy breakfast including:

- a selection of cereals
- toast/crumpets and preserves
- milk, water, squash, tea or hot chocolate

The daily cost for this provision is £4.00 per day. Children should arrive before 8.20 am if they wish to have breakfast.
