Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our Year 6 experience, we take our children on a residential visit to PGL Caythorpe. We are delighted to confirm that our current Year 5 children will have the opportunity to attend from Wednesday 8th September to Friday 10th September 2027.

What's it all about?

The PGL residential is a fantastic opportunity for children to have fun while taking part in a wide range of adventurous activities. The activities are designed to help children develop new skills, build confidence, work as part of a team and challenge themselves.

The residential also gives children the opportunity to become more independent and learn more about themselves as individuals. We feel this is a particularly valuable experience at the beginning of Year 6 as they start their final year at primary school and prepare for the transition to secondary education.

We have chosen PGL because of its extensive experience in organising residential visits for schools and its high standards of safety and care.

What will it cost?

The total cost of the residential visit is £240.00 per child. This can be paid in instalments through Arbor prior to the visit.

- All meals
- Accommodation
- Comprehensive travel insurance



Targeted Pupil Premium Support

If your child is in receipt of Targeted Pupil Premium, the school will subsidise the cost of the residential visit. You will only need to pay the £40.00 deposit, with the school meeting the remaining cost of the visit.

We hope that this support will enable as many of our children as possible to benefit from this valuable residential experience.
