### Ks2 Reading Challenge Menu

It's easy! Read a book, complete an activity, hand it in and collect your points!

The more you read, the more activities you can do, the more points you will collect!

The child, in each year group, with the highest number of points, at the end of each term, will receive a PRIZE!

Design a new cover for the book you have read (think front and back and all the information that needs including)  5 points	Write a book review for your class library shelf – remember to include information about the characters, the plot and who you would recommend the book to.  10 points	Draw a story map of the book making sure you include all the main events of the story. Don't forget to annotate it!  5 points	Draw and annotate a picture of the main character from your book. Include in your annotation as much information about them as possible.  8 points
Write the opening paragraph of a sequel to the book you have read  15 points	Find out about the author of the book and write a short biography of their life.  15 points	Copy out 3 sentences or phrases you really liked in the text. Explain what it is you like about each of them  10 points	Draw and annotate the setting(s) which are depicted throughout the book.  8 points
Choose a suitable point in the book and write an alternative ending.  15 points	Create a new character for the book. Think about how they would fit into the story, what their relationship is to the current characters?  8 points	Your book is being turned into a film. Design the advertising poster for the film? Think about the detail needed on the poster!  8 points	Write a letter to the author of the book. Explain to them what you did and didn't like about their book.  10 points

The point scores shown are the maximum number of points available for that task. It will be up to your teacher's whether you are awarded full marks. Points will be awarded for the quality of the piece of work produced including your handwriting and the content. If you need any resources to complete your task, for example paper, please ask your teacher.
