- Australia (also known as Australasia and Oceania)

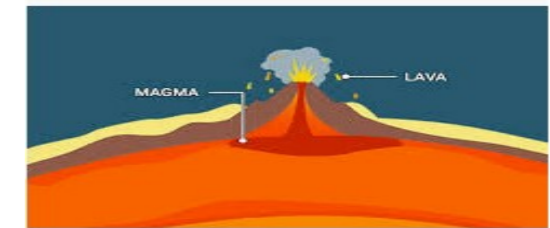

landmass	A continent or a large body of land



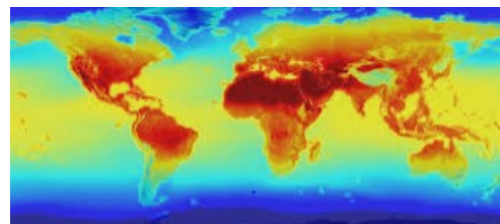
What do we mean by oceans and continents?

'Environment' means the world around us. It can refer to just the place we live or the whole world.

'Weather' is all about whether it is hot, cold, rainy, sunny or snowy. It can change hour by hour. It can be sunny in the morning and cold and wet in the afternoon. The climate changes very slowly over thousands of years.

'Climate' is the weather in an area over a long time.
