Arrangements for Wednesday 3rd July

- Children are to arrive at school at the **NORMAL TIME** and come into school through the usual playground gates.
- Children enter the school, with their luggage through the **GYM** side doors.
- Mrs Alexander and Mr Kightley will be in the gym to meet the children.
- Mrs Alexander will direct children where to put their luggage and direct them to their classrooms.
- Mr Kightley will be collecting any medication – please ensure that medication is in a named bag with clear written instructions detailing the quantity of medication that needs taking and the time and frequency. **ALL MEDICATION MUST BE HANDED IN, INCLUDING INHALERS.** Children's inhalers will be carried by the staff member responsible for your child's group.
- Children are to take any pocket money into the classroom with them where Miss Copping (4K) and Miss Greaves (4L) will be waiting for them.
- Please ensure pocket money (**maximum £5**) is in a **NAMED AND SEALED ENVELOPE.**
- Once the bus arrives, we will collect our luggage from the gym and head out to the front car park.
- We envisage that we will be leaving at **approximately 9.30am**, if parents wish to wave the bus off from the front car park.

If there is an emergency and we need to contact you whilst we are away, during the hours of 8am - 4pm we will contact the school and the office will ring you. Out of these hours we will contact you directly. If any of your contact details have changed since completing the medical/contact forms please let us know ASAP.
