Dear Parent(s)/Carer(s),

The class termly newsletter is an update of what we will be covering this term. Please see the reverse side for important notices regarding your child's class.

Topic: Going Wild!

Literacy—In fiction we will be focussing on story plots. In non-fiction we will be looking at recount texts and gathering information on animals. We will continue to use talk for writing and drama to support us with our writing.

Maths — This term we will be focusing on statistics, position and direction, and measure. We will continue to work on using our number skills to solve number problems and reasoning questions.

Science—We will be finding out about animals in the local environment. We will also be visiting Woodside Wildlife park.

RE—We will be reading stories from the Bible exploring feelings of ourselves and others.

PE—In gymnastics we will be exploring high and low movements. In game we will be focussing on multi skills. We will use animals as our theme for dance. Miss Dickson's class will have PE on Monday and Wednesday. Mrs Lee's class will have PE on Tuesday and Friday.

Art and Design— In art we will be exploring printing. In design we will be exploring levers and slides and making a moving animal mask.

Geography— We will be using atlases to locate the different countries animals come from.

ICT— We will use ICT to find information about the different animals in our science topic.

Music— We are going to be exploring instruments and symbols, creating short musical phrases.

Homework— KSI homework is used to support the development of basic skills. Children will receive homework on a Thursday which is due in on the following Tuesday. Spellings will be sent out on a Thursday and the children will be tested on the following Wednesday for Miss Dickson's class and Friday for Mrs Lee's class.

Reading — Your child's home/school diary should act as their reading record. It is expected that children read at least three times per week at home to ensure progression and continuity. Children will change their school books weekly and will take home two books. The books will be reviewed regularly and your child will read at least once a week within a guided reading session. The children will also visit the Library once a week.
